

Club History

Organized in 1939 and incorporated in 1940 as Park Gun Club, Inc., the Club was originally located in St. Louis Park, MN. Due to the area's rapid growth the Club relocated to Bloomington, MN in 1941 near 78th St. and Normandale Blvd., and again in 1951 to the current site in Orono, MN. The Club now operates as Park Sportsmen's Club.

Park Sportsmen's Club is a member owned and operated, non-profit corporation organized to provide affordable trap shooting for members and non-members alike. Everything at the club is built and paid for through shooting and membership fees, as well as countless volunteer hours, operating, maintaining, and improving the facility.

The Club offers four regulation trap fields which have modern auto loading target throwers capable of throwing singles and doubles. Trap house one is also capable of throwing double targets that oscillate vertically as well as horizontally.
