NEW LEAGUE OPERATIONS FOR SCORING TEAM ROUNDS 2026

Purpose of the Change:

The club is facing increased operating costs. To help keep trap shooting affordable, members will begin scoring their own rounds to reduce the need for paid help.

Why Costs Are Increasing:

- Facility improvements such as the new roof
- Replacement of trap machines
- Rising costs of targets, insurance, utilities and general maintenance
- Labor

How Members Can Help:

- Teams will score their own rounds.
- Voice-release systems eliminate the need for a button-puller
- Every team has capable scorers, helping reduce staffing needs and keep shooting affordable.
- If a team is lite on scoring help, they will have to ask another team member to score

Expectations for Board Members:

- Board members will be trained in proper scoring procedures
- They will assist teams or individuals unfamiliar with scoring

Scoresheet Training

- Training is available for team captains on practice Sundays before League starts (start date TBD – weather permitting)
- For team captains that missed Sunday training, training is mandatory on the first night of league
- Team captains are responsible for training their team members

Expectations for Teams:

1. Each team must designate a scorer before shooting begins
2. When your squad is called, pick up the score sheet from the clubhouse
3. After shooting, return the completed score sheet to the cashier immediately

Additional Notes:

- Captains or number one shooter, will sign to verify accuracy
- Scoring is part of good sportsmanship and should be done honestly
